Current and Former CSC Members: Logging onto the Website for the First Time

If you are a current or former CSC member and do not have your permanent user name and password, use the following directions to activate your CSC online account:

On the upper right-hand corner of the website home page, you will see "Member Login." Click this.




You will then see a login form asking for your username and password. Since you don't have these yet, click the button that



Fill in the information and click OK.

If the system recognizes your email and first name combination, it will respond: "Your username and new password have been emailed to you." says "Forgot my username password."

That will bring up another form asking for your first name and email address.



If it does **not** recognize your email and first name combination, it will tell you. Check the email address and name that CSC has for you (look at recent emails from us) and try other possibilities that occur to you. If the system still doesn't recognize any of these, you may need to go enroll as a new member. If you are sure that there has been a mistake, please email us at <u>info@CoastalSeniorCollege.org</u> with your CSC membership information and we will try to assist you.

The email sent to you will have your username and a temporary password.

Use these to login to the website and then set up your permanent username and password that you can remember.



And now you are all set.
